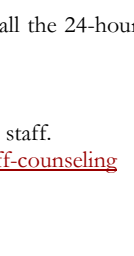

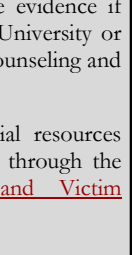

Confidential Advocates are confidential resources for survivors. They are available 24/7 through the [Office for Violence Prevention and Victim Assistance](#). An advocate's role is to:

- Assure that the survivor is aware of and understands their various legal, medical and university-based options,
- Talk with the survivor about their feelings and concerns,
- Provide ongoing support during the time of crisis and during any medical or legal process.

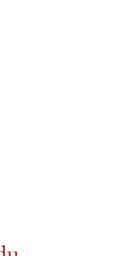

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 is a federal law that prohibits sex discrimination in education. It provides that no person shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving federal financial assistance. Sex misconduct includes, but is not limited to: sexual harassment, sexual assault, stalking, and relationship violence.

TITLE IX COORDINATORS
(Non -Confidential)*

Title IX Coordinators serve as the central points of contact for complainants of sexual misconduct and oversee the administration of this Policy in a neutral and equitable manner. The Title IX Coordinators are also responsible for overseeing the University's response to all reports and complaints of sexual misconduct, and identifying and addressing any patterns or systemic problems revealed by such reports and complaints. 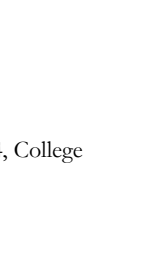

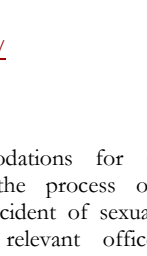
